Subject: Urgent Attention to CUET (UG) - 2023 Candidates of Tamilnadu State – reg.

The National Testing Agency is in process of inviting online Application Forms for Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG) – 2023] as per the Public Notice dated: **09 February 2023**.

A few representations have been received from the candidates of Tamilnadu State Board who have passed their Class 10 examination in the year 2021. Due to the COVID outbreak, no examinations were conducted for 2021 batch of Class 10. Accordingly no marks were given in the marksheet and 'pass' is printed in all subjects with a disclaimer – “As per G.O. (Ms) No. 48, School Education (G.E.) department dated: 25.02.2021, all candidates who studied SSLC in the academic year 2020-21 are declared passed.”

To support the students from Tamilnadu state, it has been decided that during the filling up of the **online Application Form of CUET (UG) - 2023**, when candidate selects ‘Passing year’ as **2021** with ‘School Board’ as **Tamilnadu State Board of School Examination (Secondary)**, the **Result Mode field will be disabled and the associated fields for Marks / CGPA will be invisible for Tamilnadu State Board candidates who have passed their Class 10 in year 2021.**

For those candidates who have already filled the application form, with passing year as 2021, School board as Tamilnadu State Board of School Examination (Sec.) and paid the fee, the same rule will be applied i.e. field Result Mode will be disabled and fields Total Marks, Obtained Marks, Percentage of Marks will remain invisible in the online Application Form of CUET (UG) – 2023.

With reference to the modification mentioned above, it is further re-iterated that no candidate will face any adverse issue with respect to filling-in of CUET (UG) - 2023 Application Form.
